Which endangered animal is which?

Write 'P' for the panda, 'T' for the tiger and 'B' for the polar bear.

Habitat

- It lives in the Arctic.
- It lives in the forests of China.
- It lives in the forests, woods, grasslands and mangrove swamps of Asia.

Physical characteristics

- It has an orangey-brown coat with white fur under its body and black stripes.
- It has a white coat with black fur around its eyes, ears and legs.
- It has thick, creamy-yellow fur and brown eyes.

Diet

- It eats bamboo.
- It eats wild pig, deer, antelope and buffalo.
- It eats seals, walruses, beluga whales, narwhals, seaweed and birds' eggs.

Interesting facts

- It hunts at night.
- It can swim and run up to 55 kilometres an hour.
- It eats 12 hours a day!

Population

- There are only 1,600 in the wild.
- There are only 5,000-7,000 in the wild.
- There are only 20,000-25 000 in the wild.
