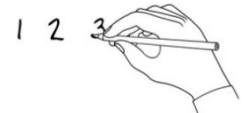

Match the words with the definitions.

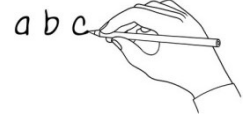
rude	→	it covers a person's or animal's body

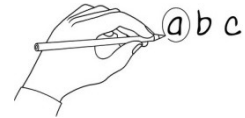
