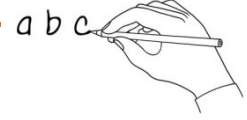

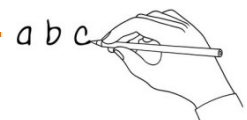


1. What's the word?

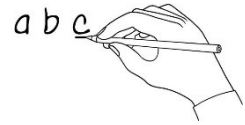
