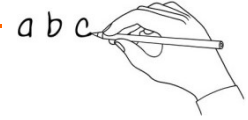






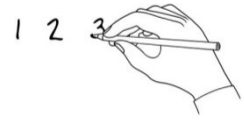


## 2. Match them up!

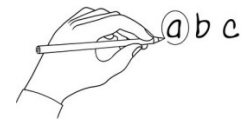
3. What's the order?
