



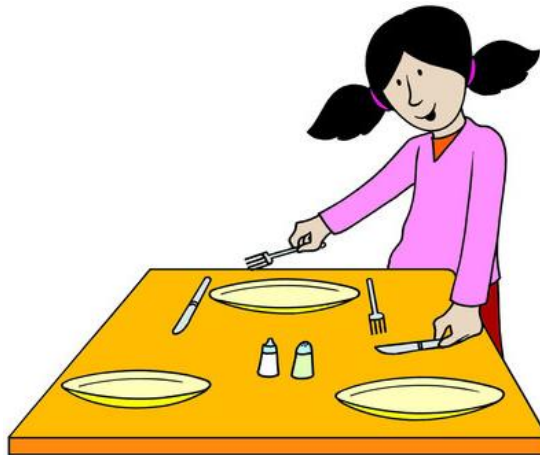
## Practise English in everyday situations

## Top tips
