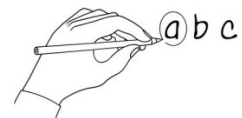

Match the words with the definitions.

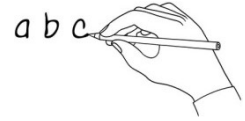
nearly	→	Something you put in a place to make it look nice
