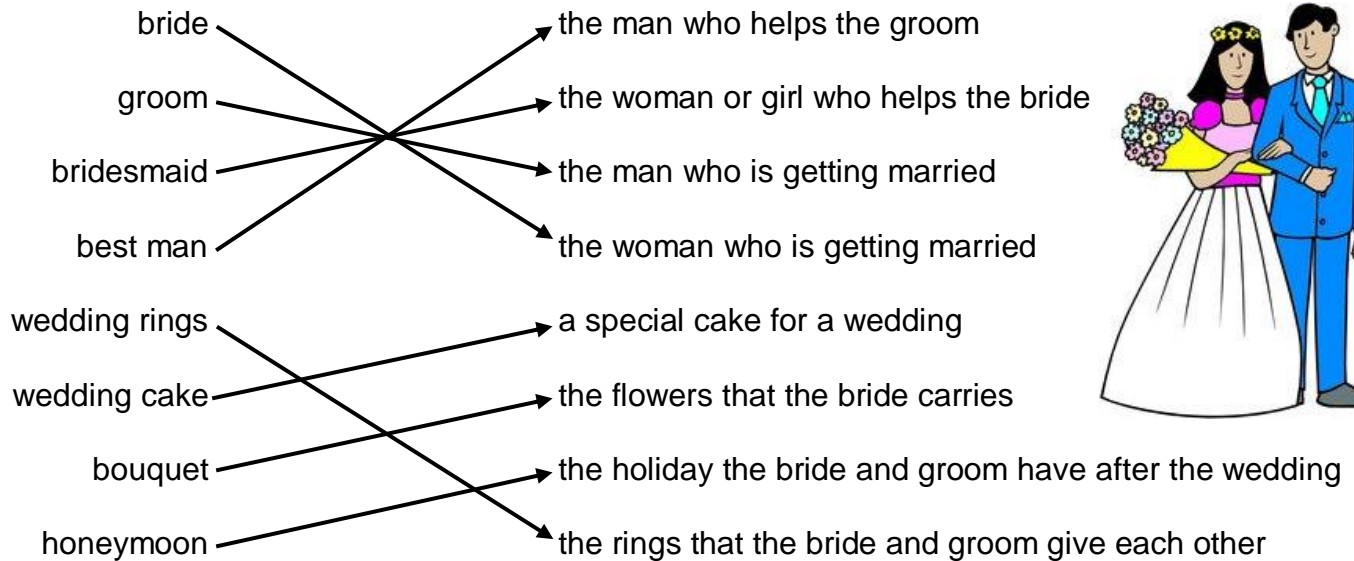

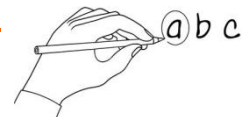

Match the wedding words and the definitions.

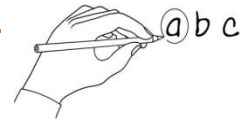
