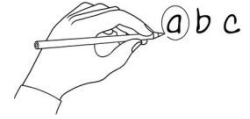




## Prepositions of time - ANSWERS

### 1. True or false?

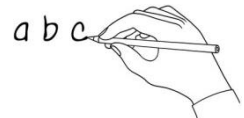
Read and circle true or false for these sentences.

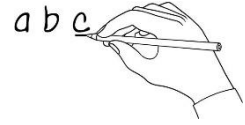


### 2. Where does it go?
