



Modals - must and mustn't

"You must listen!"



Examples

*I **must** do my homework.
You **mustn't** be late for class.
We **must** wear our school uniform.*

Remember!

We can use 'must' to talk about rules. For the negative, we can say 'must not' or 'mustn't'.

*Parents **must** take care of their children.
You **mustn't** shout in the library.
She **must not** forget her books.*

Be careful!

The main verb is without 'to'.

*He **must be** careful when cutting food.
I **mustn't make** a mess.*
