



**Prepositions  
of time**

**"I wake up  
at 8:00"**



**Examples**

*I was born **in** April.  
He goes to the park **on**  
Saturdays.  
She wakes up **at** 7:00.*

**Remember!**

We use 'in' for months and years, 'on' for days and dates, and 'at' for times.  
**in** January / July / 2014  
**on** Sunday / Friday / May 1<sup>st</sup>  
**at** 11:30 / 4 o'clock / half past two

**Be careful!**

We can use 'on' for special days and 'at' for special times too.  
**on** my birthday / New Year's Day / the last day of school  
**at** midnight / bedtime / dinner time
