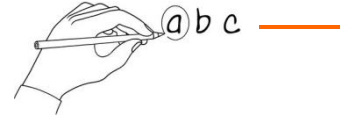




## Too big, too small - ANSWERS

We can use *too* + adjective to say when something is more than we want.

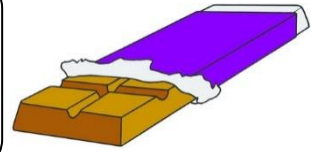


### 1. True or false?

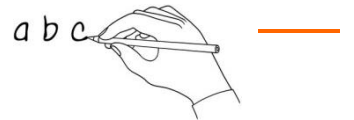
Read and circle true or false for these sentences.

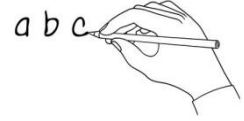


### 2. Fill it in!

- Do you go to university? No, I'm too young!
- Can you buy the biggest diamond in the world? No, it's too expensive!
- Do your parents go to school? No, they're too old!
- Can you climb Mount Everest? No, it's too difficult/high!
- Can you wear your dad's shoes? No, they're too big!
- Can you pick up an elephant? No, it's too heavy/big!
- Can you touch the top of a tree? No, it's too tall!
