

Modals - could and couldn't

"I could swim."



Examples

I **could** swim when I was four.

I couldn't ride a bike when I was three.

Remember!

We use 'could' and 'couldn't' to talk about our abilities in the past.
She could play chess when she was seven.
I couldn't run when I was a baby.

Be careful!

After 'could' and 'couldn't' we use the infinitive without 'to'.

I could **make** a cake when I was six.

My mum couldn't swim when she was a child
