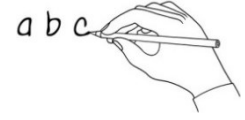

Write the word under the pictures.

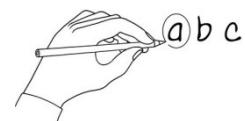

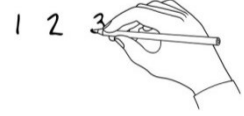
