

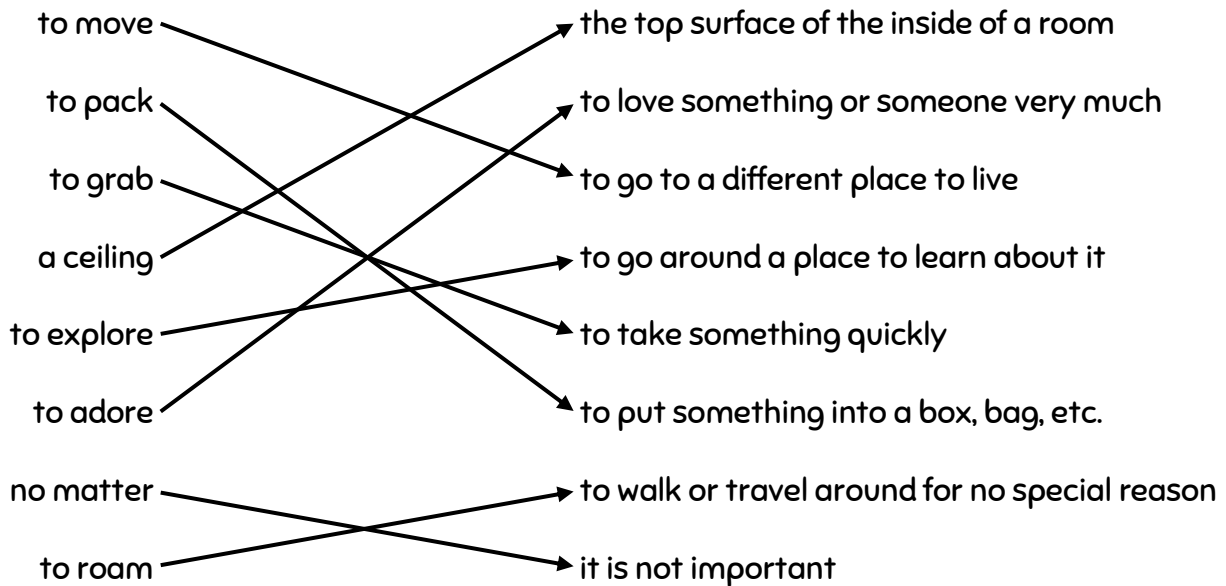

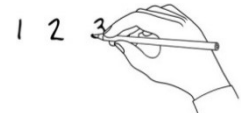

Match the words with the definitions.

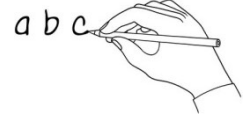


2. What's the order?

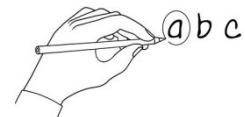
