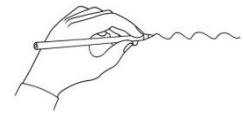

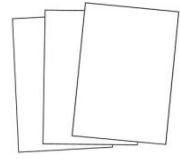

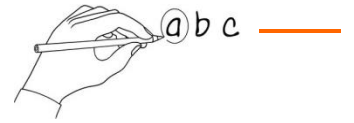
Fun run!

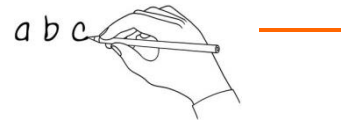

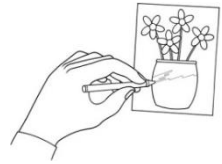
