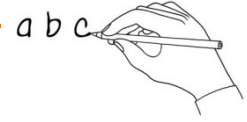
















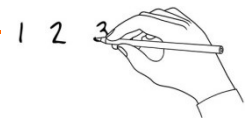
# Florence Nightingale - ANSWERS

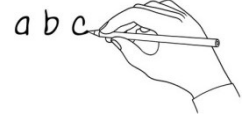
