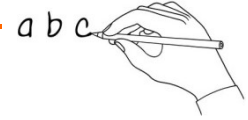




My favourite clothes - ANSWERS

Write the word under the pictures.

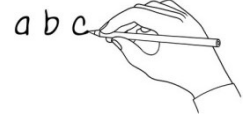
