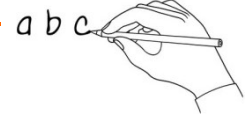














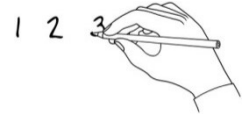

Watch the story. Draw a line to match the character and their name.

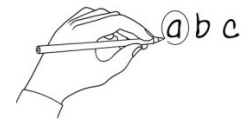
