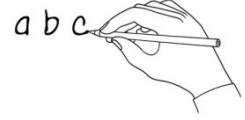

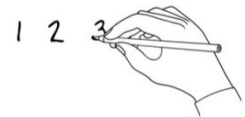


1. What's the word?

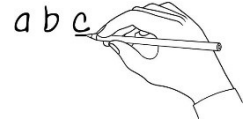

Watch the story and put the sentences in order.

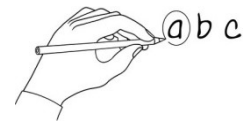
