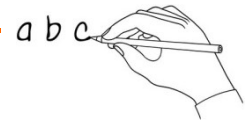


## 1. What's the word?

Watch the story. Write the missing words in the sentences.

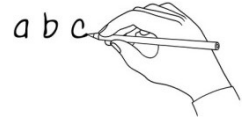
- My brother is a special vet.
