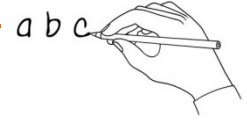














## Can a flea climb a tree? - ANSWERS

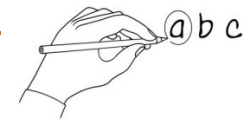


### 1. What's the word?

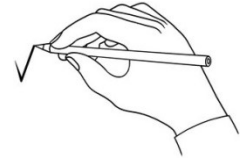
### 2. Choose the answer!

3. Ask your friends!

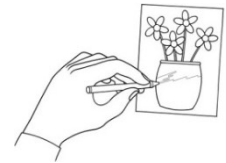


Children use their own ideas to write questions. Then they ask the questions (maximum ten people). They count how many people say yes. Then they make a chart from the answers as in this example.
