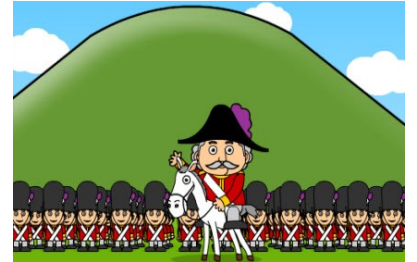




## Grand Old Duke
