



## Organising: Tips

Here are some tips for organising activities.

- Be enthusiastic about activities – your children will learn to be enthusiastic about English if you are.
- Don't worry if your child doesn't speak or use new language immediately. They need time to process the language and will start speaking when they are ready.
- Children have good days and bad days, and their concentration will vary. If they seem to be losing concentration or interest, you can say 'Never mind. Let's try again later/tomorrow' so they don't feel pressured.
- Be patient, give encouragement and praise your child for their efforts!
