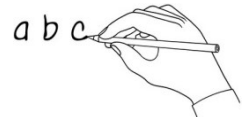
1. Match them up!

- a trusted adult → responsible

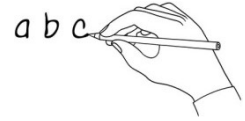

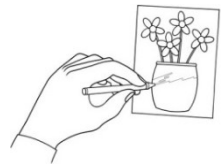
