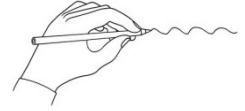




How to make a Hanukkah menorah card

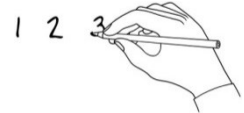

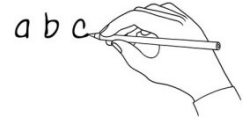

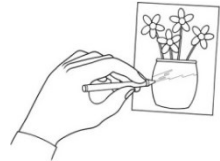
