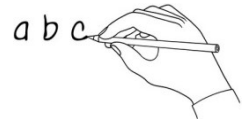

| lift-off | → | shiny, metal paper that you use to cover food |

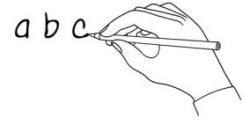
